ABSTRACT/POSTER SUBMISSION

- If you have already completed your poster, you may submit your completed poster for review in lieu of an abstract
- If you have not completed a poster, you must submit an abstract of your research
- The acceptable character limit range for the abstract is 2500 characters.
- Please download the *abstract template* and follow the format carefully. If the abstract template is not followed as is, you will be asked for revisions.
- We encourage you to send an informative abstract (complete abstract) which is a summary of a paper's substance including its background, purpose, methodology, results, and conclusion.
- Deadline to submit abstract is September 10th, Thursday before 5 pm.

POSTER GUIDELINES

Selected authors will be invited to present posters and **notification for poster presentation will be sent before Wednesday, September 16th, before 5 pm**.

FORMAT

• Posters *must* reflect the material summarized in your title.

Posters must provide the following:

- A HEADING that includes title, authors, and their affiliation(s). This heading must be mounted at the top.
- All other components including TEXT, FIGURES, and GRAPHS should be legible;
- Please include: Methods, Results with Illustrations, Summery / Conclusion, and References;
- Make poster presentations as self-explanatory as possible;
- Data displayed (Photos, figures, diagrams, charts) should be clear and concise;
- Avoid abbreviations and acronyms without first identifying their full form.

POSTER PRESENTATION

- Abstracts and posters will be reviewed. Selected abstracts/poster will be chosen for oral presentation via a Zoom platform. All other submissions will be included in the program for that day, however will not be presenting your poster orally. We are working on providing a chat session for posters not chosen for oral presentation to provide young investigators feedback on their work.
- Poster Presentations is scheduled to occur on Wednesday, September 23rd, 9:35-10:05 am.
- Details of the zoom link for poster presentations will be sent separately to the selected presenters.
